

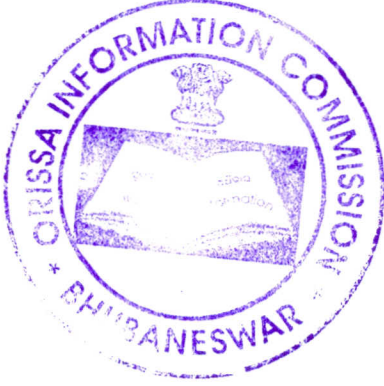

Decision

1. Complainant Pramod Kumar Nanda is present. Both the PIO and the First Appellate Authority of the office are absent. Heard the Complainant. Perused the case record. He had sought in form A application dated 2/4/2007 from the PIO regarding certain information relating to his sudden transfer from Bolgarh Block, Nayagarh district vide his letter attached to the application.
2. The case was earlier heard on 20/11/07, 27/6/2008 and 30/9/2008. This matter arises out of his form E application dated 11.06.07 accepted as a complaint petition after scrutiny under the Orissa Information Commission (Appeal Procedure) Rules,2006
3. On 26.06.2008 the State Commission had directed the Superintendent of Police -cum First Appellate Authority, Khurda district, Khurda to conduct an inquiry in presence of the Complainant and supply required information to him, free of cost.
4. The Superintendent of Police-cum- First Appellate Authority had intimated vide letter no.5046 dated 11.12.08 that the Complainant did not attend the inquiry in the fixed date. However, he conducted a Suo -motu enquiry and submitted his inquiry report to the State Commission.

A copy of the report of the Superintendent of Police, Khurda was given to the Complainant, by the State Commission.

5. On perusal of the report of the Superintendent of Police, Khurda the State Commission observed that there was no delay in responding to the Complainant. This was confirmed by the Complainant. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed without any orders of penalty. Inform the same to the PIO and the First Appellate Authority.
