Decision

1. Both the Complainant Sheikh Ismile and Nalini Kanta Mohanty, PIO, Balipatna Block, Khurda district are present. Heard them. Perused the case record. This case arises out of complaint petition dated 02/08/08 and heard earlier on 07/07/09.
2. Complainant has sought information in form A application dated 30/05/08 from the PIO, Balipatna Block on unauthorized digging of a tank on plot no.122 of Dhanahara village.
3. The PIO submitted that the Complainant had earlier filed four RTI complaints which had been registered as Complaint Cases no.468/08, 621/07, 514/06, and 843/07. In all the above four cases, information had been fully supplied to him. In this complaint case the Complainant had received on 23/06/09 all the information under due acknowledgement. The PIO further

submitted that the Complainant was making vexatious application time and again in order to harass them, though all the required information have been supplied to him on time as specified under Section 7(1) of the RTI Act, 2005. The PIO strongly refuted the allegations of the Complainant that the information supplied to him were wrong and false. He further submitted that he had not denied any information to the Complainant; rather they had acted in good faith and supplied on time the required available information. The Complainant had no grievance to express today.

4. After hearing both the parties, the State Commission found that the Complainant had already received all the required information and there was no delay in this matter. Therefore, the case is disposed of and closed.
