Decision

1. Complainant Pravakar Dixit is absent on call. The same is condoned under Rule 9(2) of the Orissa Information Commission (Appeal Procedure) Rules, 2006. Choudhury Chittaranjan Das, PIO –cum- Fishery Extension Officer, Nimapara Block, Puri district is present. Heard and perused the case record. This case arises out of the complaint petition dated 13.9.2008.
2. The Complainant had sought information in form A application dated 31.7.2008 from the PIO, office of the Block Development Officer, Nimapara, Puri district regarding correction of wrong voterlist of booth nos. 112 and 113 of Nimapara Assembly Constituency etc. The details of queries have been mentioned in the form A application of the Complainant, which are on record.
3. The PIO-cum- Fishery Extension Officer, Nimapara Block submitted that he had received on 08.08.2008 by post the form A application of the Complainant. As the booths came within the jurisdiction of a particular G.P of Nimapara Block, he forwarded the same to the G.P.E.O for immediate necessary action. After receiving on 01.09.2008 the required information from the latter, he had supplied the information the same date to the Complainant under certificate of posting (as requested by the Complainant).

The Complainant had personally received another set of the required information from the VLW/ Executive Officer of the local GP with due acknowledgement after depositing Rs.50/- towards the cost of the information as per the stipulation under RTI, Act, 2005.

4. In view of the facts stated above, the State Commission observed that as the Complainant has received his required information as borne out by documents, after depositing the cost of the information there is no issue left for further consideration. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed with no orders of penalty. The PIO is exonerated. Inform the Complainant.
