Decision

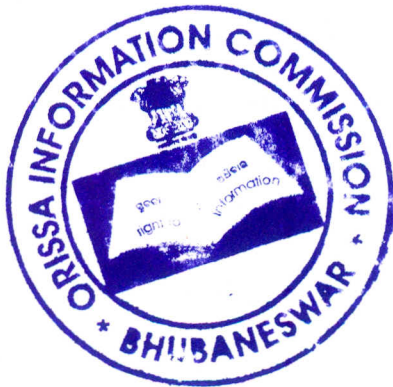
1. Both the Complainant Nirmal Kumar Rana and PIO, Raghunath Panda, PIO, of the office of the District Inspector of Schools, Boudh are present. Heard them and perused the case record. This case matter arises out of complaint petition dated 28/7/2007 under section 18 (1) (c) of the RTI Act, 2005.
2. Complainant had filed a form A application (undated) which was received on 16.06.2007 by the PIO, office of the District Inspector of Schools, Boudh seeking information relating to “(i) sanction of increments since 2003 to 2006 vide DIS order no.2119 dated 7/8/2006 (ii) E.L. sanctioned from 10/12/2003 to 11/12/2003 and 15/12/2003, 3/12/2004 to 9/12/2004 (sanctioned vide order no.3799 dated 20/5/2009 (iii) Held up pay released for 13/7/2006 (sanctioned vide order no.3843 dated 21/12/06 (iv) Increment arrears and (v) E.L. sanction from 16/2/2007 to 12/2/2007”.


In response thereto the PIO collated the information and intimated the Complainant to come and receive the same. Complainant received all required information on 13/7/2007 on acknowledgement on the reverse side of his form A application.

3. During course of hearing Complainant admitted before the State Commission that he had received all required information within the maximum prescribed time limit and had unwittingly submitted the complaint petition.
4. As the Complainant has received the required information and the PIO provided the same within the prescribed time limit, the State Commission decided to dispose of and close the case without any orders on penalty. The PIO was exonerated.
