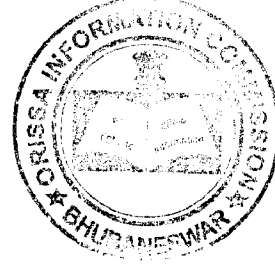

**Decision**

1. Complainant Sri Bijaya Chandra Gantayat and both the PIO and 1st Appellate Authority of the Orissa Governor's Secretariat are present. Heard both sides. Complainant Sri Gantayat submits that the PIO and 1st Appellate Authority have not furnished the information to him in response to his application for Presidential reference about the reliefs allegedly given to him in the judgment passed by the Hon'ble High Court in OJC No. 1307 of 1991.
2. It reveals from the record that the PIO and 1st Appellate Authority have communicated their decisions to the Complainant and the copies thereof have been received by him under his own signature. They have also prepared a report indicating parawise compliance of the request of the Complainant,

the copy of which has also been received by the Complainant today during
