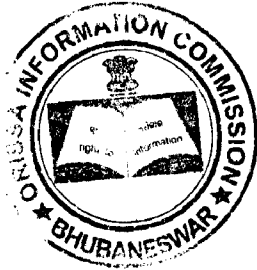

Decision

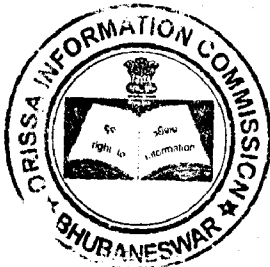
- 1 The Complainant is absent. He has authorized his son Sri Debasish Hota to appear on his behalf, which was accepted. Sri Durga Prasanna Mohapatra, PIO (OP) Rajendra College, Balangir (College for short) is present. Heard both sides in detail.
- 2 It is seen from the Complaint petition and the submissions of the parties that the Complainant sought for information from the Opposite Party on 09/02/06. He got some of the information on time, i.e. on 18/02/06 from the OP. He alleges that information provided to him were incomplete and misleading.
- 3 The PIO (OP) of the College submits in reply that whatever information was available in the College have been given by him to the Complainant. It is pointed out on behalf of the Complainant that photocopies of the notesheets which relate to the retrial benefits of the Complainant though available in the College records have not been provided. The PIO (OP) orally undertakes before the State Commission to provide the said copies to the Complainant within 7 (seven) days.



- 4 The State Commission after having taken into consideration the above submissions of the parties, direct the Complainant to deposit the amount required for the copies of the said notesheets within 2 days after which the PIO (OP) will furnish the same to him positively within 7 days to be computed from the date of deposit of the required fees by the Complainant. The PIO (OP) shall clearly indicate in a letter addressed to the Complainant that the information that are available in the Higher Education Department, Govt. of Orissa or Directorate of Higher Education. The Complainant may, if he desires approach the PIOs of the said Public Authorities to expedite his right of access to information guaranteed u/S 3 of the Right To Information Act, 2005.
- 5 Last but not the least, the parties are directed to report compliance of the directions which have been given to them, to the State Commission through the Registrar on or before 05/09/06.
- 6 The Complaint Case is accordingly disposed of.
